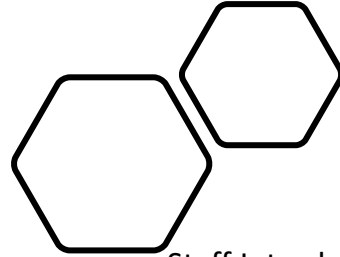

2026 GHSA ELIGIBILITY



- KEYS TO ELIGIBILITY
 - Remain in good academic standing each SEMESTER while playing sports in high school.
 - Pass AT LEAST 3 out of 4 classes each semester.
 - FIRST YEAR, FIRST SEMESTER 9TH GRADERS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR ATHLETICS DURING THEIR FIRST SEMESTER OF HIGH SCHOOL.
 - TO BE ELIGIBLE AFTER 1ST SEMESTER, 9TH GRADE STUDENT MUST HAVE PASSED 2.5 (3) CLASSES.
 - AFTER 9TH GRADE YEAR; STUDENT MUST PASS 5 CLASSES.
 - AFTER 10TH GRADE YEAR; STUDENT MUST PASS 11 CLASSES.
 - AFTER 11TH GRADE YEAR, STUDENT MUST PASS 17 CLASSES.
- TRANSFER STUDENTS
 - (STUDENT AT CAMPBELL FOR LESS THAN 12 MONTHS & DOES NOT INCLUDE 1ST YEAR FRESHMAN)
 - You will be required to fill out a Form B that is to be sent to the GHSA.
 - **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Rough Cost to put your player on field.

- **Cobb County does not fund athletic programs within the schools**, which means that our program relies upon player participation fees and is even more heavily reliant upon the Spartan Club to grow and expand the Campbell Football Program. The types of things that registration fees go to pay for are:
 - Capital Investments/Facilities maintenance and improvements.
 - Helmets, pads, game, and practice uniforms
 - Weight Room and Training equipment
 - Video equipment, technology, and services (Hudl)- Photos & Films
 - Training equipment, sleds, and other field equipment
 - Team Meals/Food/Drinks
 - Trainer and first responder presence at all games (county requirement)
 - Transportation
 - Scholarship programs
 - Coach stipends and clothing
 - Janitorial service
 - Banquet
 - Laundry
 - Player Swag
 - Recruiting Service
- Also worthy of note are the costs of outfitting a Spartan Football Player:
 - Helmet - \$400 -700
 - Helmet Decals - \$ 35
 - Mouthpiece - \$3
 - Annual helmet reconditioning - \$150
 - Practice Jersey - \$40
 - Shoulder Pads - \$350
 - Game Jersey - \$220
 - Belts - \$15
 - Game Pants - \$130
 - Knee Pads - \$10
 - Practice Pants - \$35
 - Workout T shirt and shorts - \$60
 - Travel Bags-50
 - Recruiting Profile- 50
 - Total Cost: \$ 1548-1848
- **Any player caught throwing or damaging equipment will be charged \$150 dollars through my payment plus.**

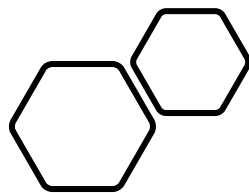

- We will have meetings/tutoring after school from 3:40-4:30 on Tues/Wed



PRACTICE ATTENDANCE

- **ABSENCES** – Attendance will be taken at EVERY football related event including conditioning and practices.
- Injuries – See onsite trainer, FIRST
- **Attendance:**
 - All students are required to promptly attend all practices, games, meetings, camps, fundraising activities, and workout sessions as scheduled by their coach. In addition, Failure to do so will result in:
 - First Miss Practice = Miss 1 Quarter
 - Second Miss Practice = Miss 2 Quarters
 - Third Miss Practice = Miss the Game
 - ALL students are required to inform their coach PERSONALLY if they are to be absent. For a missed practice or tardy to be considered excused, the player must personally contact a coach through one of the following methods:
 - 1. Call or speak to a coach or leave a message for each level's coach.
 - 2. Personally tell one of the coaches that you will be late or missing practice.
 - **NOTE: The coaching staff must accept the excuse as a valid one. If not sure, please contact.**
- Excused missed practice= Family emergency, medical, Illness- Covid or Flu w/ Dr. note on return, prior approval from Head Coach.
- Unexcused missed practice= dentist appointment, finishing homework, baby-sitting, detentions, minor illness, Birthdays, Hair appointments, Vacations, DMV,

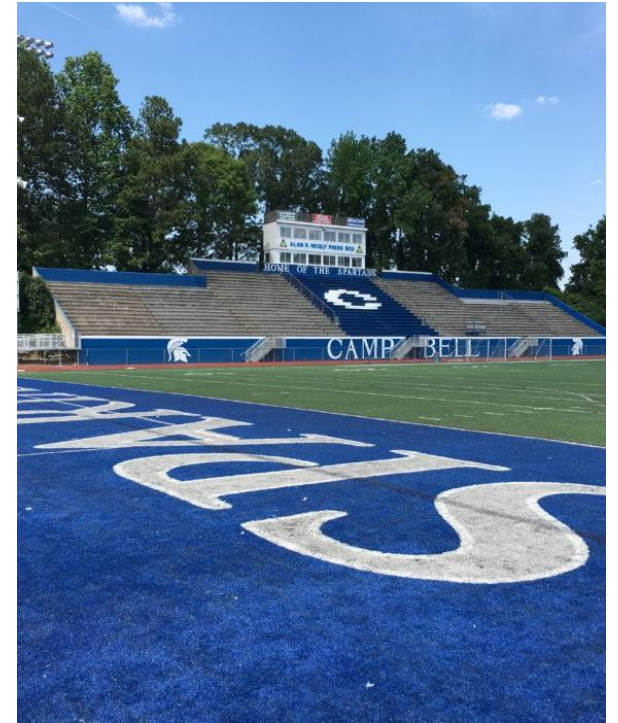


Parent Communication/Relations

- Coach Communication on how to help your child improve will take place in this order. Parents should speak with
 - (1) Speak w/ Son
 - (2) Son and Position Coach
 - (3) Son and Offensive Coordinator or Defensive Coordinator
 - (4) Coach Phillips & Position Coach to schedule meeting.
 - (5) No Meetings after a game (36 Hour Rule before Contact)
 - (6) Meetings are arranged thru email. Meetings will be no longer than 15 minutes on Monday during school hours or before start of practice.
- After practice if emergency remember we have families to.
 - All responses may take up to 24hrs.
 - Remember its 1 coach but 100+families
- Parents are held accountable for their conduct at all football and athletic related events. Conduct detrimental to the overall program and our athletes will be disciplined and can have your athlete removed from the team and possible school related discipline.
